#### Loosening the Knots That Tangle Your Self-Worth

- ~ Identify the shame-messages that are stealing your joy and confidence
- ~ Understand you were Divinely created on purpose for purpose, and the He delights in you!

### The Power of Forgiveness

So often, we want to hold on to the offense because we think it's a way to punish the offender. We feel like letting it go means we think they're blameless. But God knows that until we forgive, we'll stay knotted up inside. It will keep us chained to the person and the pain. This talk will make the case for forgiveness, and will encourage you to:

- ~ Discover where you are holding onto offense
- ~ See the reasons God commands us to forgive and understand the blessings that come from it
- ~ Learn practical ways to walk it out in relationships and circumstances

#### **Overcoming the Fear Factor**

Fear is a big deal. Truth be told, we all struggle with it. We're afraid to let others down. We fear rejection or abandonment in relationships. We worry we're not the right kind of mom or wife... friend or daughter. We're afraid our best isn't good enough. But God is clear in his Word that fear is not from Him. So what do we do?
